

Science Direct features

- Contains the full text of articles from more than 2000 journals
- Includes articles on all sciences: engineering and computer science, earth & resource sciences, physics, chemistry, biology, medicine, etc., and some articles in arts and humanities, and in social sciences
- Includes linked article outlines and a mechanism for emailing the author(s)
- Scirus: Searches for scientific information on the Web, e.g. scientists' home pages, conferences, patents, etc.

Accessing and Using ScienceDirect:

1. Starting at the library's home page (lib.umflint.edu), click the link, *Periodicals: Indexes & Full Text* in the left column
2. In the left margin, click on the link *ScienceDirect*
3. Click on the *Search* button at the top of the page
4. Type terms to be searched in the search boxes. Default is to search abstract, title and keywords, but this default can be changed using the drop-down menu on the right. For example, to search for articles by a particular author, use the drop-down menu to select "author."
5. The default is to search all types of sources at once, but you can limit your search to a particular type of source (e.g. journal, or reference book) by clicking the box(es) to the left of the source type you want to search.
6. The default is to search for material in all subject areas, but you may limit your search to a particular subject area (e.g. computer science and/or engineering) by choosing a subject from the drop-down menu next to "Subjects." To choose more than one subject area, hold down the "Control" button while you click the subject areas you want to search.
7. The articles in your search results are usually available in the following formats:

<p><i>SummaryPlus</i> Provides abstract, citation and references</p>	<p><i>Full text + links</i> Full text with links from text to sources cited and links to charts and images</p>	<p><i>PDF</i> Full text exactly as it appears in the journal issue</p>
